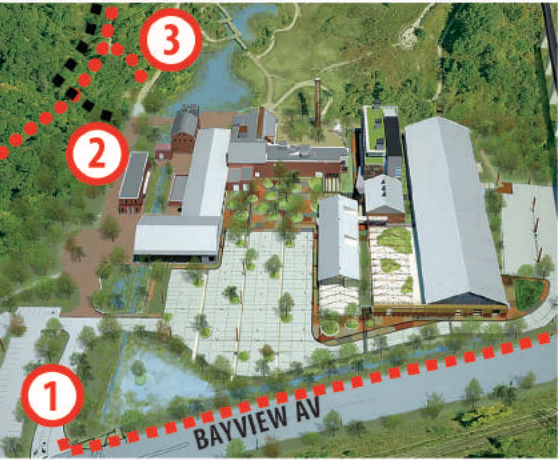


DESTINATION MAP

A Unique Site. Rich in Possibility.

From 1889 to 1984, this site was home to the Don Valley Brick Works factory, one of Canada's pre-eminent brickyards. When it closed down, the site was abandoned, leaving behind an industrial brownfield and a damaged ecosystem.

Restored and revitalized by Evergreen, a national not-for-profit that inspires action to green cities, Evergreen Brick Works is now a global showcase for green design and urban sustainability.

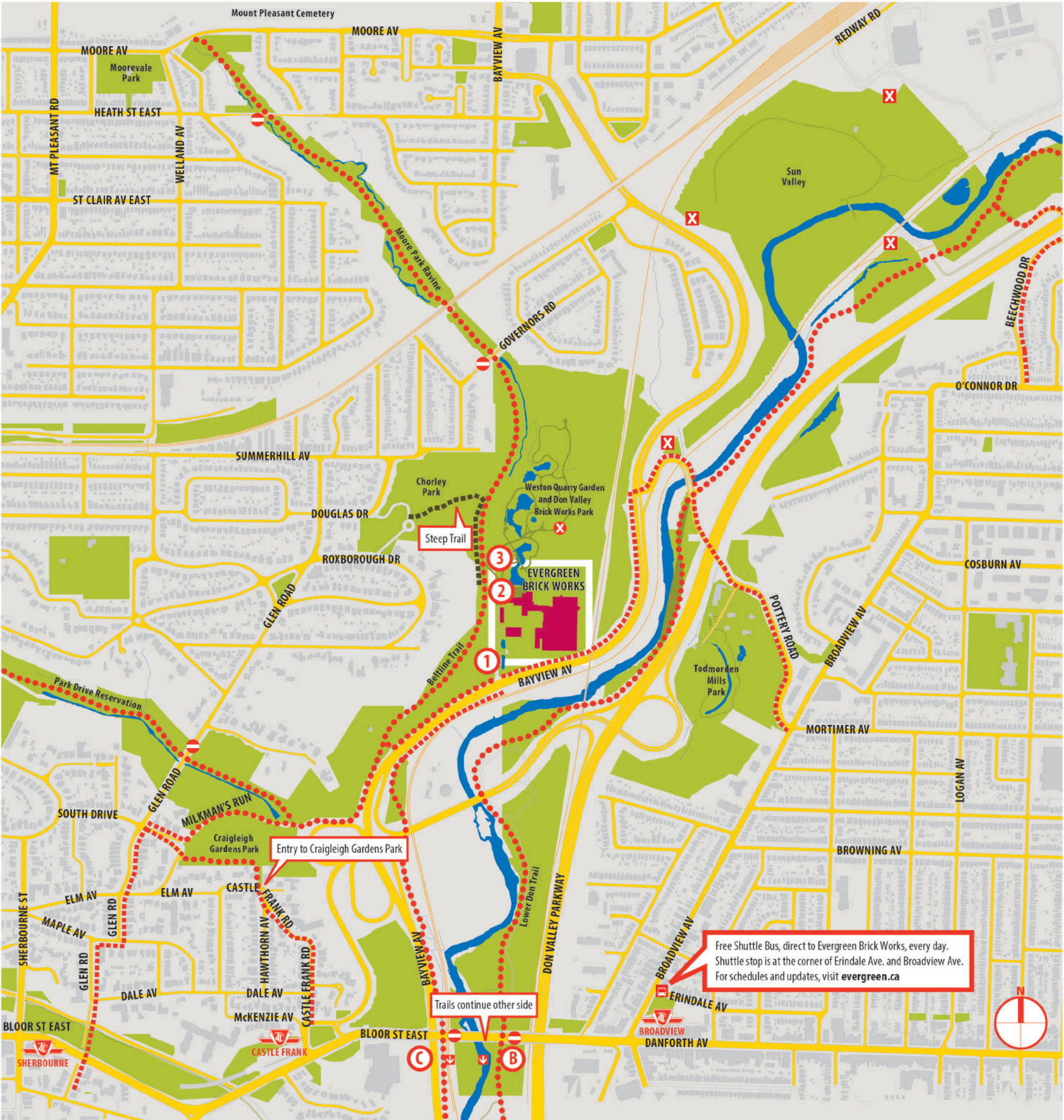

Evergreen Brick Works is a community environmental centre that inspires and equips visitors to live, work and play more sustainably.

We are located at 550 Bayview Avenue, south of Pottery Road.

BIKING AND WALKING

Use this map and leave your car and cares behind as you follow the trails to Evergreen Brick Works by bike or on foot.

It takes approximately 20 minutes to walk to Evergreen Brick Works from Castle Frank and Sherbourne Subway Stations, or Beechwood Drive.

FREE SHUTTLE BUS

Evergreen operates a free shuttle bus from Broadview Subway Station 7 days a week. Visit us online for the shuttle bus schedule.
